- Office Christmas Closure: Christine has been brainstorming ways to recognize staff and show appreciation for how hard they all work. Our agency does not have the highest wages or benefits, so trying to find other ways to acknowledge them and have more staff retention. One of the ideas she came across was, the Vernon Family Resource Centre closes for two weeks over the Christmas break and the first week is paid by the agency as a "bonus" to employees to spend time with their loved ones and have a break from the high stress jobs they all lead. The WCRC budgets already allow for the wages for those who are scheduled to work the first week of Christmas, so there is no financial barrier to WCRC being able to provide the same to its employees. The contract hours for the counsellors are already being over provided, so no risk of not meeting contractual obligations. Last year during the closure the local RCMP had Christine and Val's number in case of an emergency and the message was updated to include emergency numbers, as well as, the phone was checked for messages on the three additional days closed. Last year we did not have any emergencies or emergent messages. Clients understand our staff also need to recharge.

The new principal of CBSS is Josh Gutknecht, he has been the Vice-Principal at the school last year and the beginning of this year. He was also the VP at JW Inglis for several years prior to moving to CBSS. Josh has agreed to take Melissa's place on the Board. He lives in Lumby and is dedicated to our community and the school community, he will be a great asset to the Board.

The ones really struggling do not go to counsellors as they don't want anyone to know. They suffer in silence. We need to reach them. All kids.
