## The Family Support Program

A family counselling program that assists the whole household, parents, teens and/or children.

## Mental Health & Addictions Information, prevention and counselling

The purpose of this program is to provide individual and group counselling services to children, youth and adults who are experiencing issues related to mental health and/or substance misuse.

## Adult Counselling

Short term counselling available for a variety of issues including communication skills, anger management, marital, grief and stress.

## School Based Outreach Program

Support for students where home or community is impacting their ability to be successful at school. Referral is through school-based team.

## Resource Library

Containing a wide variety of helping books, pamphlets, and videos on topics such as health (Alzheimer, arthritis, etc.) family (pregnancy, children, etc.), training opportunities (resume writing, public speaking, etc.), and more.

There is also computer access for creating resumes, or printing documents.

## Community Information Boards

Boards are located at the White Valley Resource Centre, Village of Lumby Office, Whitevalley Community Hall, Senior Drop-In Lounge, and in Arbor Park. Postings include workshops, special events, and critical information.

## Community Pride

This program provides youth with up to 40 hours of paid employment. Suitable people are connected with local organizations that mentor youth enabling them to build interpersonal, communication and organizational skills. As well, these opportunities will build job skills, expand resumes, and if available, give access courses such as Food Safe, WCB Level 1 and SuperHost. 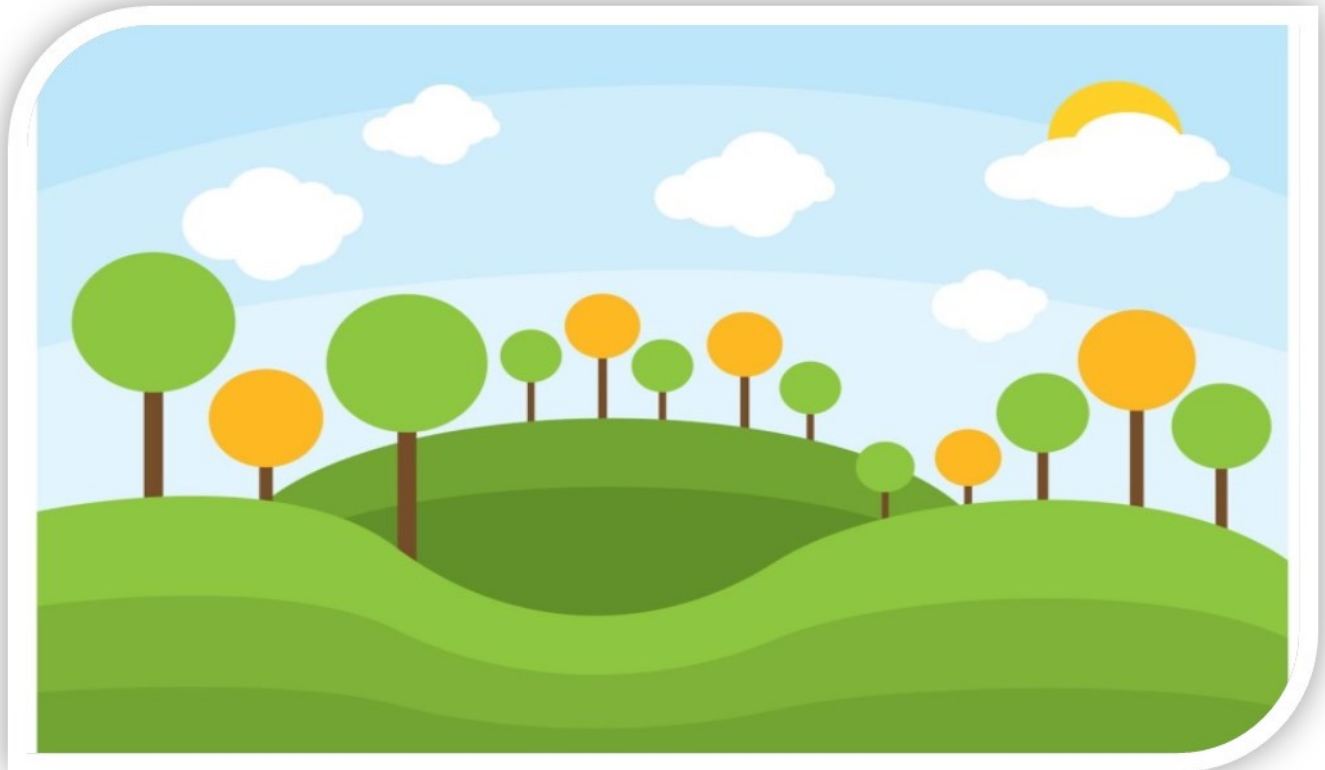

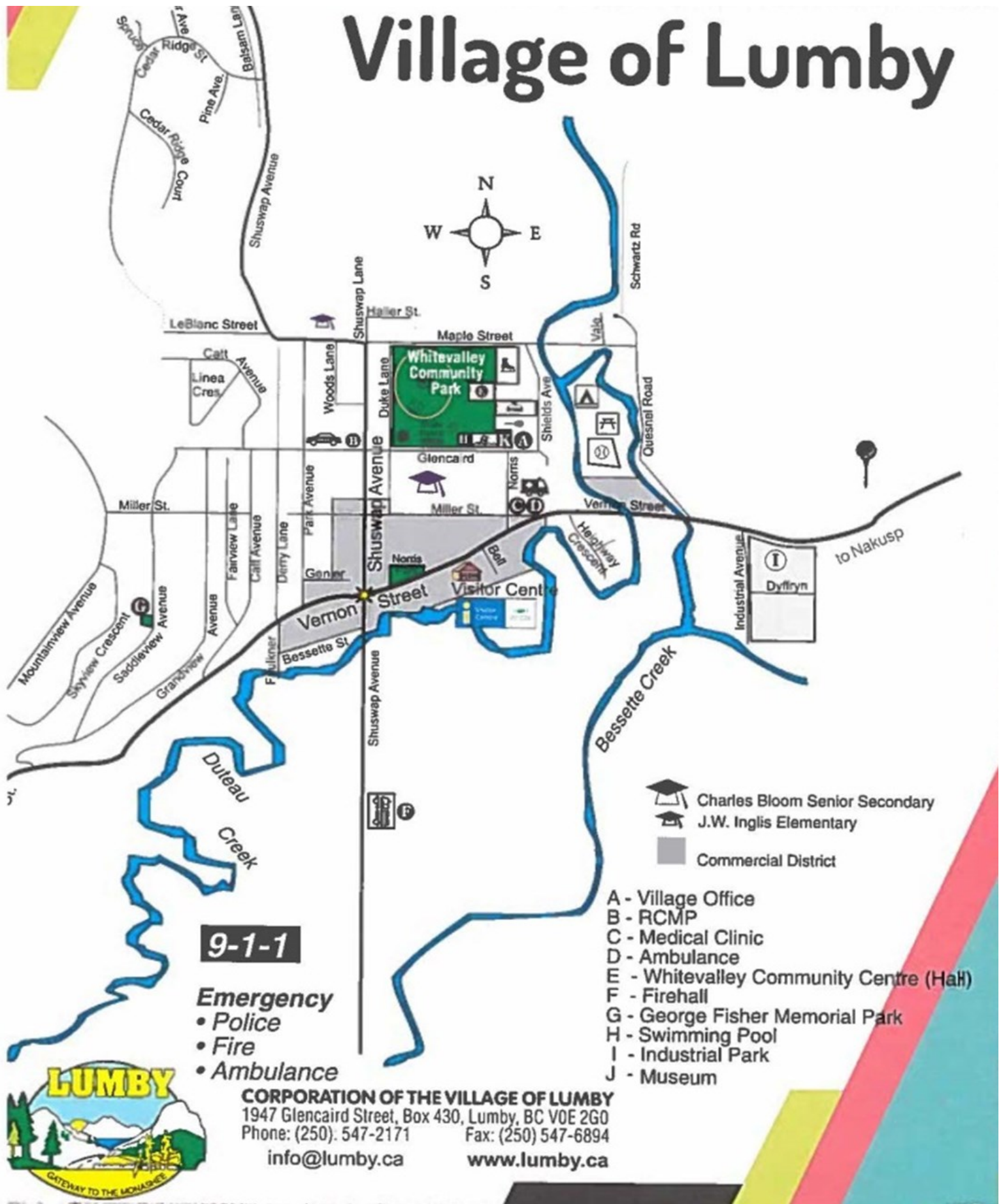

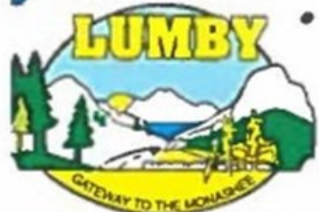
